

STATE OF HAWAII FIREARM CERTIFICATION FOR RETIRED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

Star Protection Agency has been awarded the contract to conduct firearm certification to carry a concealed firearm for Qualified Retired Law Enforcement Officers (QRLEO). The Law Enforcement Officers Safety Act of 2004 (LEOSA) authorizes these qualified retired law enforcement officers to carry a concealed firearm if they meet certain standards.

Retired law enforcement officers who wish to carry a concealed firearm need to apply with the State of Hawaii Attorney General office. Information on how to apply can be accessed on the State of Hawaii Attorney General web site. The Attorney General Office will compile a list of qualified applicants and send it to Star Protection Agency (Star). Once the list is received, Star will contact the QRLEO and inform them of available dates for the classroom lecture and firing range qualification.
